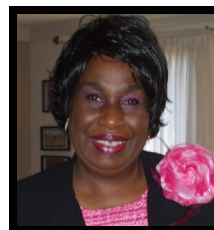

Juanita L. Coston on Cultural Conversations



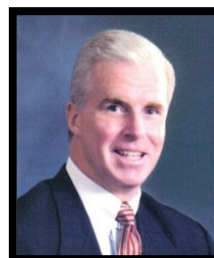
